### **Update on TCCS Activities**

### Report by Dr. R. Gowribalan, Project Lead, Coodal

Coodal has made progress in initiating TCCS projects in the North, particularly in the Vavuniya, Kilinochi, and Mannar districts.

### a. Vavuniya TCCS

Funds allocated: Distributed across four TCCs.

- 1. Chettikulam:
  - o 12 projects funded. ₹6 Lakhs
  - Harvest completed; awaiting rice sales.

### 2. **Maruthodai:** ₹5Lakhs

- 10 projects funded.
- Awaiting progress report.
- 3. Pulvanayar: ₹5 Lakhs
  - 10 projects funded.
  - Project reports received.
- 4. **Oonchalpity:** ₹10Lakhs
  - 10 projects funded.
  - No progress report received.

### b. Kilinochi TCCS ₹20Lakhs

- Funded by Board member Dr. Pushpam Moorthy.
- Agreed funding for four TCCs.
- Feedback shared via the CIC Coodal WhatsApp platform.

# c. Mannar TCCS

- Agreed to fund one TCCS.
- Projects pending finalization.
- No funds disbursed yet.

# d. Badulla TCCS

- 4 villages participating.
- Limited participation in providing feedback.

### **Action Plan to Address Feedback Issues**

We are not receiving timely progress reports from funded TCCs. To address this, we have sought assistance from two sources:

### 1. **On-site Visit:**

• Mr. Ranjan Sivagnanasundaram from Vanni Hope (currently in Sri Lanka) will visit the villages and submit a report.

### 2. Youth Engagement via Zoom:

- Organized a Zoom meeting with Badulla youths, facilitated by Thirandal Middukku.
- Each of the 9 projects received funding of ₹50,000 from Coodal.
- Undergraduate students visited all 9 projects in Siharam TCCS. We are awaiting their report.
- Coodal funded the expenses incurred by this team.
- If successful, this group will extend visits to other TCCs in Badulla.

# AGM 2025

Board members will discuss and agree on a date and venue for the next AGM in the Board meeting on 13 March 2025.

### **Application for Charity Status with the Charity Commission UK**

- All necessary steps have been taken to apply for charity status in the UK.
- Expected completion time: 6 months.
- The benefits of obtaining charity status were discussed and agreed upon in the Board meeting on 30 January 2025.
- Dr. Christie Jesuratnam, a Coodal member, shared his experience in achieving two charity applications.
